

Field Treasurer/Accountant



Opportunities

The field treasurer in Uganda is responsible for the handling and disbursement of all field funds, including deposits, transfers, cash flow, salaries, medical expenses, etc. The field treasurer also provides supervision for any Ugandan staff working in the finance office.

Requirements

Preferably, the field treasurer should have training in generally accepted accounting principles; knowledge of computers, budgeting, and cash flow; a willingness to drive in the city; and a bachelor's degree in accounting, management, or finance. Experience in nonprofit accounting is desirable.

Training Provided

Prior to leaving for Uganda, WGM Headquarters staff will provide training in specific job responsibilities. Additional training is provided by WGM Uganda staff.

Kampala, Uganda

Length of Service

- **Short-term: four weeks to one year**
- **Long-term: two or more years**

Ministry Description

Through this ministry, the field treasurer gives oversight to the management of WGM Uganda finances. Through the day-to-day activities of this position, opportunities will arise for a spiritual ministry to Ugandans and missionaries. WGM Uganda participates in church ministries, children's and youth ministries, community health and development, education, refugee care, university student outreach, and other ministries.
