It is the first private university in Bolivia and the first evangelical university in Spanish-speaking South America. The main ministry of BEU is to reach the youth of Bolivia for Christ through higher education and to influence Bolivia and other countries through its students and graduates.

- BEU offers 13 majors, including communications, theology, and electronics in addition to a master's degree in missiology.
- Approximately 2,000 students attend the university each year.
- Students are granted a *licenciatura* (bachelor's degree) upon completion of a five-year program that includes a thesis defense.
- In addition to its list of majors, BEU operates its own educational radio station, agricultural center, daycare center, and medical center with an operating room.
