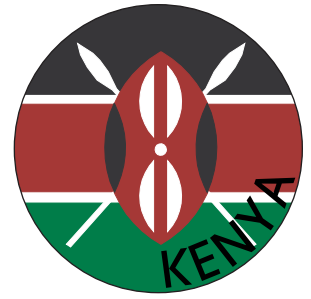

Opportunities

Join the medical and spiritual ministries at Tenwek Hospital College of Health Sciences by assisting nursing students in classroom and clinical areas as they train in a three-and-one-half-year program to be triple-qualified as nurses, midwives, and community health nurses. The opportunities will vary depending on the teaching schedule and the clinical rotation schedule.

Qualifications

A minimum of one year of experience as a nurse or midwife is required. Experience in teaching or clinical supervision is helpful.

Length of Service

- **Short-term: six weeks to one year**
- **Long-term: two or more years**

Ministry Description

The Nursing Program at Tenwek Hospital College of Health Sciences (formerly Tenwek School of Nursing) ministers under the motto "Care in Christ's Name" and has been providing qualified nurses to Tenwek Hospital (Bomet, Kenya) since June 1987. The purpose of the program is to train Christian Kenyan young people to become competent nurses who can provide physical, emotional, and spiritual care to their patients. At any given time, 70 to 80 students (usually 50 percent male and 50 percent female) from all over Kenya are attending the school, which is a government-recognized institution.

- Tenwek Hospital began as a small clinic in the 1930s and is now one of the largest Protestant mission hospitals in Kenya. It is located 140 miles west of Nairobi in the fertile highlands of the Bomet district.
- Working under the motto "We treat, Jesus heals," Tenwek's staff treats more than 11,000 inpatients and 80,000 outpatients annually and also performs approximately 3,000 major surgeries and 2,500 deliveries each year.
- In addition to the medical work being done at Tenwek, several thousand people find Christ as Savior each year, and many more are impacted through the hospital's compassionate ministries and training programs.
