## Opportunities

- Statistically, 92 percent of Argentines are Roman Catholic, but less than 20 percent practice their faith. In addition, 2 percent of Argentines are Protestant, 2 percent are Jewish, and 4 percent practice other religions.
- Argentines are known for their nocturnal lifestyle of eating late and enjoying the late evening hours. Normal dinnertime in Argentina is between 9 p.m. and midnight.
- Argentines are considered quite sociable and outgoing, and they view themselves this way too. A cultural survey found that the most important spare time activity for almost 80 percent of Argentines is visiting friends and relatives.
