DECEMBER

Let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

Matthew 5:16 (ESV)

As you seek to be transformed by God, gather pictures of the people you know who are also seeking this change. Global workers, family, friends—lift them to the Lord and ask that their impact would spread outward for the Father's glory.

JANUARY

The steps of a man are established by the LORD, when he delights in his way.

Psalm 37:23 (ESV)

Make a list of the resources God has blessed you with. Pray over that list, asking God to reveal anything you need to surrender as you enter this new year. Pray that He will align your heart with His as you seek to walk forward in His will.

FEBRUARY

Imitate God, therefore, in everything you do, because you are his dear children. Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ.

Ephesians 5:1–2 (NLT)

Pull up a map of your community and pray for your neighbors, local schools, nonprofits, and churches, asking God to reveal ways He wants you to reach out to them. Pray for opportunities to share Christ's love with others.

MARCH

Our children will also serve him. Future generations will bear about the wonders of the LORD.

Psalm 22:30 (NLT)

Visit wgm.org/content-map, choose a country, and pray for the future generations who will serve there. Ask that the Lord will raise up mentors for them now who will be able to help lead them.

APRIL

What you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.

2 Timothy 2:2 (ESV)

As you read the news or scroll through social media, lift up leaders around the world, asking God to guide them. Pray for global workers in training to become leaders, that they would be filled with His Spirit as they take part in the Great Commission.

MAY

Teach me to do your will, for you are my God; may your good Spirit lead me on level ground.

Psalm 143:10 (NIV)

Pray over your calendar, submitting the days ahead to the Lord. Pray for the strength to overcome any obstacles you encounter and to keep you walking in His will.
